Situated in a pretty coastal hamlet above the truly majestic stretch of golden sand that is Mawgan Porth is Chy Dewetha, a substantial four bedroom detached house with over 1,500 square feet and a stylish, tranquil ambience.

Chy Dewetha offers generously proportioned accommodation on two levels with views across the countryside and sea glimpses from the first floor.

As you enter, one is met with a spacious hallway and open tread staircase ascending to the first floor. The ground floor accommodation consists of a kitchen/breakfast room with excellent range of base and wall units incorporating a hob, double oven, extractor, microwave, fridge freezer, dishwasher, washing machine and from here is a double glazed door giving access to the garden.

The main living space is beautifully presented and L shaped with an abundance of natural light. French doors open onto the patio at the rear. Two of the bedrooms reside on the ground floor, one is a very good size double with the other a single/bunk room. The family bathroom has a white suite comprising panelled bath, separate shower cubicle, pedestal wash hand basin, low-level WC, radiator, double glazed window and fully tiled walls.

The open tread staircase ascends to the floor landing with a Velux rooflight and under eaves storage. There are two substantial bedrooms here, both light and bright with lovely country views, one with sea glimpses in the distance. Both have en-suite shower rooms, Velux roof lights and double glazed windows.

Heading outside there is an attached garage with up and over door and tarmac driveway with off road parking for several vehicles. To the side is an external shower, convenient for beach goers. At the rear is a west facing paved patio with lawned gardens and high boundary hedging for privacy, with gated access either side. One side adjoins open farmland. Services to the property include mains gas, water, electricity and drainage. EPC rating E.

The main line train station at Bodmin Parkway is an approximate 30 minutes drive away with routes into London Paddington.

To find Chy Dewetha, head towards Newquay from Padstow along the coast road passing through St Merryn and Porthcothan along the way.
