Rosaleen is situated within a small peaceful hamlet just half a mile above the golden sands of Watergate Bay.

This characterful cottage has been in the same ownership for almost forty years and provides two double bedroom accommodation alongside a one bedroom annexe providing immense versatility.

Rosaleen has character in abundance, from the beamed ceilings and thick stone walls to the exposed stone fireplace, wood burning stove and cloam oven.

The accommodation comprises an entrance porch to access both the cottage and annexe. Rosaleen has an open plan living area with a modern fitted kitchen, integral electric oven

and ceramic hob. With beams overhead and staircase rising to the first floor, the space opens up to the living area with a large stone fireplace at the far end, home to a wood burning stove and original cloam oven. Another door leads out to a rear porch and onto the garden. Up on the first floor are two double bedrooms and family bathroom complete with bath, a white suite and heated towel rail.

The annexe accommodation has a modern fitted kitchen with integrated electric oven and hob with freestanding fridge. The annexe also has a living room, shower room and bedroom.

To the front of the cottage is a driveway with off road parking for two vehicles as well as the attached garage with up and over door. To the rear is an enclosed garden with well stocked flower and hedge borders and a central lawn.

With some light refurbishment and improvement, Rosaleen would equally serve as a permanent home or indeed as a characterful holiday home with good income potential.

Just two miles north along the coast is Mawgan Porth, now one of the most sought after locations in North Cornwall. The magnificent sandy beach is famous for water sports activities serving surfers and bathers alike with stunning cliff and coastline walks. Fine dining is available locally at the award-winning Scarlet Hotel as well as first class spa and recreational facilities at The Scarlett & Bedruthan Hotel. The bay provides a range of amenities including a local store, cafes, public house, surf school and gift shops. Rick Stein's esteemed Seafood restaurant, Paul Ainsworth's Michelin starred No.6 and cool seafood bar Prawn On The Lawn in picturesque Padstow can be found just a few miles along the very scenic coast road. Well situated for ease of transport, Tregurrian is less than a 15 minute drive off the main A30 and just 5 minutes away from Newquay Airport with its domestic and international flight services. The main line train station at Bodmin Parkway is a approximately a 30 minutes drive away.

To find Rosaleen, from Padstow follow the B3276 towards Newquay for approximately 10 miles, passing through St Merryn, Porthcothan, Mawgan Porth and Trevarrian. As you enter the hamlet of Tregurrian, pass the Watergate Touring Park on the right hand side and round the bend. As you drive through Tregurrian, Rosaleen can be found on the left hand side.
